THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to s 439A(6) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Act**) that the period within which the plaintiffs must convene the second meeting of the creditors of R.L. Buller & Son Pty Limited (Administrators Appointed) ACN 004 348 207 (**Company**) be extended up to and including 22 July 2013.
2. Pursuant to s 447A(1) of the Act that the second meetings of the creditors of the Company required by s 439A of the Act may be held at any time during, or within five business days after the end of, the convening period as extended by the Court notwithstanding the provisions of s 439A(2) of the Act provided that the plaintiffs give notice of the meeting in accordance with section 439A(3) of the Act.



3. The plaintiffs have liberty to apply for any purpose connected with the administration of the Companies including but not limited to seeking a further extension of the convening period.
4. The Plaintiffs give notice of the making of this order to the creditors of the Company, as known to the Plaintiffs, by means of a circular to creditors to be posted to the said creditors last known address by ordinary post no later than 7 days after the date of this order.
5. Any person having a sufficient interest may apply to the Court to vary any of the orders made in paragraphs 1 or 2 above upon giving 5 days written notice to the Plaintiffs' solicitors.
6. The costs of and incidental to this application be costs and expenses in the administration of and be paid out of the assets of the Company.
7. Authentication of this order by the Prothonotary be dispensed with and this Order be signed by an Associate Judge pursuant to Rule 60.04 of the Rules of Court
