### **ORDER**

#### **THE COURT ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Plaintiffs be granted leave to file in Court an Originating Process dated 23 June 2017 and an affidavit sworn by David James Frank Lombe on 23 June 2017 and the Originating Process be returnable instanter.
2. Pursuant to sections 439A(6), 447A(1) and / or 1322(4) of the *Corporations Act* 2001 (Cth) (**Act**), the date of the convening period as defined by section 439A(5) of the Act for the second meeting of creditors of the Company is extended from 7 July 2017 up to and including 8 January 2018.
3. Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Act that Part 5.3A of the Act is to have effect in relation to the Plaintiffs and the Company such that the second meeting of the creditors of the Company required by section 439A(1) of the Act may be held at any time during the period up to or within 5 business days after the end of the convening period as extended by order 2 above.
4. Liberty to apply be granted to any person, including any creditor of the Company or the Australian Securities & Investments Commission, who can demonstrate sufficient interest to modify or discharge these orders upon appropriate notice being given to the Plaintiffs and to this Court.



5. The Plaintiffs have leave to apply for any further extension of the convening period as extended by order 2 above at any time before the relevant date.
6. The Plaintiffs have liberty to apply (in these proceedings) in relation to any other matter arising in the Administration generally.
7. The Plaintiffs are to give notice of the orders made by the Court to the creditors of the Company by:
  - (a) placing a copy of the Orders made by the Court on the website maintained by the Plaintiffs at [www.deloitte.com.au/sebel-furniture](http://www.deloitte.com.au/sebel-furniture); and
  - (b) sending a copy of the Orders made by the Court by:
    - (i) email to all creditors of the Company who have provided the Plaintiffs with an email address; and
    - (ii) mail to all other creditors of the Company who have not provided the Plaintiffs with an email address.
8. The Plaintiffs' costs and expenses of this application be paid from the assets of the Company.
