

Open Energy Timeline

Open Energy is a framework under which consumers have the right to share their own energy data with third-party providers.

Phase 1 data

NMI Standing Data (network tariff code, metering installation type, average daily load, presence of a controlled load), Customer provided data (account holder name, contact details, customer appliance data information), Metering data

Phase 2 data

Billing data, Generic product data (retail tariffs, usage charges, applicable discounts for the supply of electricity to consumers), Individual product data (as Generic product data, but specific to consumer), Distributed Energy Resource Register

Phase 3 data

Gas metering data, non-NEM electricity metering data, non-NEM electricity connection point data, electricity and gas retail product data (contract offers), non-NEM electricity data
