Execution procedures of the paid public works program become electronic

The DOST Digital Innovation Center of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of Population is currently finalizing the creation of a "Public Affairs Portal".

The portal will increase transparency in the organization of paid public works and ensure the employment of unemployed people, eliminate abuses, and more effectively organize, manage and monitor labor in the field of public works.

Information about each social worker registered on the portal (social status of himself and his family members, the organization where he works in public affairs, salary, etc.) will be collected automatically obtained from the information systems of the relevant agencies. This information will be reflected in the personal account of each social worker.

In addition, the portal allows you to create a timesheet, as well as electronic personnel reports.
