



# The financial performance of the exploitation companies

**The tables give an overview of the Q values for the 9 financial key indicator of the exploitation companies.**

In the first table on the right you can find an overview of the Q1, Q2 and Q3 values \* for the period 30/09/2015 – 30/03/2016. The table below shows the Q2 median values of the past 5 years.

\*

**Q1 = percentile 25:** 25% of the companies perform less, 75% score better.

**Q2 = percentile 50:** the performance of the median company. 50% of the companies perform less, 50% score better.

**Q3 = percentile 75:** 75% of the companies perform less, 25% score better.
