Your job

Working as an Auditor provides one of the finest and fastest educations in business imaginable.

As an Auditor you will:

- develop an understanding of your clients' business and the risks they face;
- test the efficiency of the internal control system and review the design and implementation of internal accounting and operating procedures;
- provide recommendations for improved controls and enhanced business efficiency;
- approve year-end figures, checking the balance sheet and profit and loss account thoroughly;
- gain an understanding of the figures through performance of analytical procedures;
- review financial reporting of companies.

Your tasks will regularly change and your responsibility within the firm will increase. Once you know your clients well, you will build a good relationship with the Finance Director, CFO or Controller. You will get a good understanding of your client's processes and in most cases you are the first point of contact when the manager or partner has questions.

Your learning

A dedicated learning team will constantly guide and support you throughout your career.

As a Junior Auditor, you will participate in a two weeks training program in Belgium and abroad, with a focus on the basics of audit and getting your accounting knowledge up-to-speed. You will also get training on the Tools and Methodologies used within Deloitte.

After these two weeks of training, you start working at the client. The first weeks on the job may be extremely challenging since everything is new. Since on-the-job learning within Deloitte is key, other team members will give you constant guidance and support. We will make sure a clear and transparent learning path is elaborated in order to facilitate your development, focusing both on technical and soft skills and allowing you to obtain several professional qualifications. During the first 4 years at Deloitte, you will follow at least 3 weeks of training every year, some of which are extra muros and/or abroad.
