New Belgian-Moroccan social security treaty applicable per 1 June 2022

Upon conclusion of the ratification procedure in Morocco, the new social security treaty between Belgium and Morocco will enter into force on 1 June 2022. This treaty was initially signed on 18 February 2014.

It will replace the old Belgian-Moroccan social security treaty of 1968, which needed to be amended after 50 years of application.

The new treaty is open to all nationalities, includes coordination rules on assignment and simultaneous employment and further completes the old treaty in the area of health insurance.

For Belgium, the convention applies to the legislations concerning the compulsory schemes for

- Health and maternity insurance for employees.
- Benefits for accidents at work and occupational diseases.
- Retirement and survivors' pensions for employees.
- Invalidity benefits for workers, merchant seamen and miners,
- Family allowances for employees.
