

Gender pay gap in Europe

Women in the EU get paid on average 12.7% less per hour than men. In the Czech Republic, the difference is as high as 15%.



Fighting the gender pay gap

To this end, on 24 April 2023, the Council of the EU adopted the Pay Transparency Directive, which aims to strengthen gender pay equality and ensure greater transparency in remuneration.
