Welcome to Munich

Munich, also known as Monaco di Baviera – is a sunny hidden gem between mountains and lakes, with a past maintained in the present. It is a must-see city, especially due to its latest attractions. With a total height of 78 meters, the "Hi-Sky" is the largest transportable ferris wheel in the world and is listed in the Guinness Book of Records. Since April 2019 you can enjoy a panorama view of the Alps, the Frauenkirche and the Olympic area during the 30-minute ride.

The „Alte Utting“ is a nearly 40 meter long ship, built in 1950, and has been used for 65 years to take tourists on a scenic tour around the Ammersee. Since 2017, it has been one of Munich's most interesting attractions: It was rescued from scrapping and found its place on a disused railway bridge, where it has been renovated and is now used as a restaurant.

The popular Oktoberfest (Wiesn), which starts each year in mid-September and lasts for two weeks, is also a great way to experience true Bavarian tradition with 6 million people attending this unique event annually. **Enjoy your stay. Enjoy Munich.**
