### Deloitte announces 2019 Technology Fast 500™ EMEA rankings

- Average growth rate of the EMEA Fast 500 program is 1258 percent from 2015-2018
- UK's Revolut leads the charge with 39,754 percent growth from 2015-2018

**London, United Kingdom, 30 July** — A company from the UK tops Deloitte's Technology Fast 500™ rankings for Europe, the Middle East, and Africa (EMEA), which was released today. The list is compiled by Deloitte's regional Technology, Media & Telecommunications (TMT) industry group.

Overall, this year's Technology Fast 500 list for the region features winners from 22 countries, with an average growth rate of 1,258 percent in 2019, compared to 969 percent in 2018.

Revolut is the number-one ranked company on the 2019 EMEA Technology Fast 500 list.

"When Revolut was founded in 2015, we had a vision to build a sustainable, digital alternative to traditional big banks.
