A small percentage of global companies had female CEOs in 2014.

- What is happening to the rising stars on their way to the top? Why are so few women appointed to senior executive positions? Why do so many choose not to aim for the top? What can individuals and organizations do to change this?
- We have heard a great deal in the last few years about sustainability: a sustainable resource is one which endures over time; sustainability is a characteristic of a system which is resilient and is able to "keep going" without burning itself out.
