

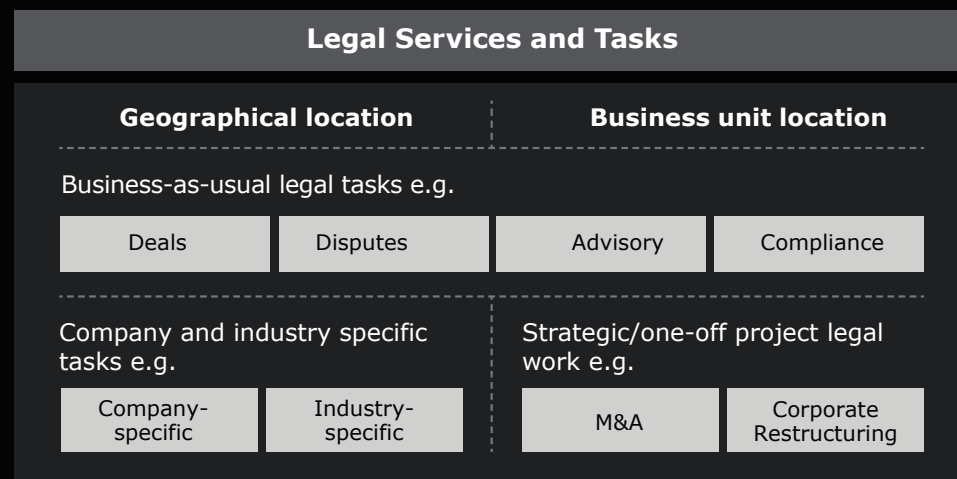
3 levels to building your in-house legal operating model

The process of developing an operating strategy for the legal department is essential, just like the foundation of a house. There are 3 levels that should be taken into consideration when building your in-house legal operating model:



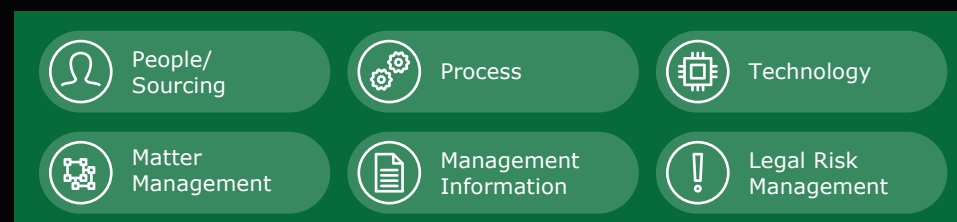
Strategic direction: Strategy based on needs of key stakeholders, clearly communicated goals, roles and responsibilities, governance standards.

Legal services and tasks: Defined legal tasks and projects divided into business-as-usual and strategic legal work. May differ based on specific industry or company requirements.

Enablers: Infrastructure which supports and monitors controls across all legal activities, making the legal department efficient and effective.
