This Cookie Notice is part of the Privacy Notice for the website hosting Conduct Watch platform (the “Website”). For more information about us and how we protect visitor information, please review the Privacy Notice for the Website to which this Cookie Notice is linked, which is always available to you in the footer section of this Website.

In the context of using the Conduct Watch Platform (hereinafter the “Website”), we use cookies to ensure that it is functioning effectively.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file placed on your device by the websites that you visit. Cookies are then sent back to the website on each subsequent visit, or to another webpage that recognizes that cookie. Cookies are used in order to make the website work, or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website. Such information may be used to provide a more personalized and responsive service. Cookies may be either first party cookies set directly by us to your device, or third-party cookies set by a third-party provider on our behalf. Whenever you use this Website, information may be collected through the use of cookies and other technologies.

Cookies we use and why

When you visit the Conduct Watch Platform, we use only first party “strictly necessary” cookies . “Strictly necessary” cookies are necessary for the Website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms.

The strictly necessary cookies we use on this Website could be categorized in the following high-level categories:

- Session cookies used to run the Website, also including facilitation of the session timeout countdown, user’s timezone identification and ensuring the security of the Website and the user;
- Other cookies that enable identification of the device’s browser type, orientation and operating system of the device, as well as the type of the mobile device used. It is noted that no association with an actual user identity(ies) takes place.

How long will cookies remain on my device?

The length of time cookies will stay on your device depends on whether it is a “persistent” or “session” cookie. A persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiration date,

unless deleted by you before the expiration date. A session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of your web session, when the web browser is closed. You may visit the **Privacy Preference Center** to view how long each cookie remains stored on your device.
