

About the qualification

Over 113 countries require or permit the use of International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) for publicly-traded companies. All listed companies in the European Union (EU) have to prepare consolidated company accounts that comply with IFRS. It also affects associates and subsidiaries of EU-listed companies. Other countries such as Australia, Hong Kong and South Africa have already adopted IFRS or equivalents as their local Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP). Many other countries around the world are moving towards applying IFRS, which is having a significant impact on financial reporting. The DipIFR is designed to develop knowledge, understanding and application of IASs/IFRSs and the concepts and principles which underpin them. Who should apply?

If you are working in practice, but not yet qualified, then you may still be eligible. You will need to prove that you have one of the following:

- Three years relevant accounting experience (by submitting a letter from your employer).
- A relevant degree plus two years work experience.
- An ACCA Certificate in International Financial Reporting plus two years' work experience.
