



Deadline for the filing of income tax return for individuals and corporations extended

Deadline now expires on 27 July 2015 for individuals and on 20 July 2015 for legal entities (instead of 30 June 2015)

Ministry of Finance decided to extend the deadline for the filing of the income tax returns for individuals and legal entities

A Ministerial Decision issued on 25 June 2015 provides for the extension of the deadline for the filing of the income tax return as follows:

Individuals

The Income Tax Return must be filed until 27 July 2015.

It is underlined that:

- The first installment is due until 31 July 2015
- A 2% discount is granted for lump sum payment of the tax due

Legal entities

Corporate Income tax return must be filed by 20 July 2015.

Lump sum discount equally applies; first installment is due upon filing of the return.
