New Energy & Resources Regulations

1. Regulation: Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) Regulation 49/2018 ([click here Permen ESDM 49/2018](#))

Date : 16 November 2018

Subject : Penggunaan Sistem Pembangkit Listrik Tenaga Surya Atap oleh Konsumen PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero)
(Use of Rooftop Solar Power Generation Systems by Consumers of PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero))

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 49 of 2018 was established with the considerations to promote development of business, the solar panel industry, and encourage the utilization of renewable energy for use of environmentally friendly energy. Rooftop solar power generation systems (PLTS) include a solar module, inverter, electrical connection, security system, and export/import kWh meter. The capacity of a PLTS system is restricted to a maximum of 100% of the installed capacity of the PLN customer as determined by the total inverter capacity. A customer that intends to construct and install such a system must submit a system construction and installation request to the General Manager of the PLN

main regional/ distribution unit. The request will be evaluated and verified within no longer than 15 working days from when the properly completed application is received. The customer may only construct and install the system after receiving approval from PLN. At the time this regulation comes into force, Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 01 of 2017 concerning Parallel Operation of Electric Power Generators with the Electric Power Network of PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero) is declared null and void insofar as it relates to the use of rooftop PLTS systems by consumers of PT PLN (Persero). This regulation came into force as of 16 November 2018.

2. Regulation: Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) Regulation 48/2018 ([click here Permen ESDM 48/2018](#))

Subject : Penetapan Objek Vital Nasional Bidang Energi dan Sumber Daya Mineral
(Designation of National Vital Objects in the Energy and Mineral Resource Sector)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 48 of 2018 is established as a form of simplification and refinement of regulations to facilitate investment in the energy and mineral resource (ESDM) sector. The meaning of national vital objects (Obvitnas) in the ESDM sector is areas/locations, buildings/installations, and/or businesses relating to the necessities life of the public), the national interest, and/or strategic sources of state revenue in the ESDM sector. The Secretary General of the Ministry of ESDM will conduct an inventory and verification to designate Obvitnas. In addition, a business entity or permanent establishment may submit a request to be designated as an Obvitnas. This regulation came into force from 16 November 2018 and revokes and declares null and void Minister of ESDM Regulation Number 4 of 2017 concerning National Vital Objects in the Energy and Mineral Resources Sector.

3. Regulation: Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) Regulation 47/2018 ([click here Permen ESDM 47/2018](#))

Subject : Tata Cara Penetapan Tarif Tenaga Listrik
(Procedure for Setting Electric Power Rates)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 47 of 2018 is established with the considerations to provide guidelines in determining electricity rates for consumers. A holder of an electric power provisions business license (IUPTL) that has a business region for a distribution business, electricity sale business, or integrated electricity supply business shall apply electricity rates for consumers in the context of selling electric power to consumers. The Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) shall set electricity rates after obtaining the approval of the People's Representative Assembly (DPR) or the governor after obtaining the approval of the provincial legislature (DPRD). The electricity rates that are set may be adjusted periodically based on the basic costs of provision of electric power plus a reasonable business profit. To obtain determination of electricity rates, an IUPTL holder that has a business region shall submit a request to the Minister of ESDM or the governor, who shall conduct an

evaluation no later than 14 calendar days after the request is received. This regulation came into force from 19 November 2018.

4. Regulation: Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) Regulation 46/2018 ([click here Permen ESDM 46/2018](#))

Subject : Perubahan Ketiga Atas Peraturan Menteri Energi Dan Sumber Daya Mineral Nomor 26 Tahun 2017 Tentang Mekanisme Pengembalian Biaya Investasi Pada Kegiatan Usaha Hulu Minyak Dan Gas Bumi
(Third Amendment of Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 26 of 2017 concerning Mechanism for Recovery of Investment Costs in Upstream Oil and Gas Business Activities)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 46 of 2018 is established with the considerations to provide legal certainty for the mechanism of refund of investment costs at the end of the period of a cooperation contract in upstream oil and gas business activities. Based on this regulation, the refund of investment costs will be settled by the new contractor no later than 7 days after the end of the cooperation contract, if the cooperation contract is not extended. If there is a delay in the refund of the investment costs and there is a provision on imposition of a fine in the mechanism for settlement of the refund of investment costs, the new contractor can be subjected to a late fine of a maximum of 2.5% per day. This regulation came into force from 16 November 2018.

Subject : Perubahan Atas Peraturan Menteri Energi Dan Sumber Daya Mineral Nomor 41 Tahun 2018 Tentang Penyediaan Dan Pemanfaatan Bahan Bakar Nabati Jenis Biodiesel Dalam Kerangka Pembiayaan Oleh Badan Pengelola Dana Perkebunan Kelapa Sawit
(Amendment of Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 41 of 2018 Concerning Provision and Utilization of Biofuel of the Biodiesel Type in the Context of Financing by the Oil Palm Plantation Fund Management Agency)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 45 of 2018 is established with the considerations to facilitate implementation of payment of the shortfall between the market index price of Diesel Fuel and the market index price of Biodiesel. The changes stipulated in this regulation relate to implementation of determination of the market index price of Diesel Fuel and to the implementation of verification to obtain the Biodiesel Financing Fund. This regulation came into force from 17 October 2018.

6. Regulation: 2025 K/30/MEM/2018 ([click here 2025 K/30/MEM/2018](#))
Date : 3 December 2018
Subject : Harga Mineral Logam Acuan dan Harga Batubara Acuan untuk Bulan Desember Tahun 2018
(Reference Prices of Metallic Minerals and Reference Price of Coal for December 2018)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision Number 2025 K/30/MEM/2018 sets the reference prices of metallic minerals for 20 metallic mineral commodities and the reference price of coal which prevail during December 2018. The Reference Prices of Metallic Minerals (including reference prices for metallic minerals in the form of Nickel, Cobalt, Lead, Aluminum, Copper, Gold, Silver, and others) and the Reference Price of Coal will be used as the basis for calculation of the Benchmark Prices of Metallic Minerals and the Benchmark Price of Coal for December 2018.

Subject : Penetapan Harga Minyak Mentah Indonesia Bulan November 2018
(Determination of Indonesian Crude Oil Price for November 2018)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision Number 2024 K/12/MEM/2018 specifically sets the average price of Indonesian crude oil for November 2018 at US\$62.98/barrel. In addition, the prices of 56 types of Indonesian crude oil, both categorized as main crude oil and other crude oil, are set in detail in the attachment to this decision. This Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision came into force on 3 December 2018.

8. Regulation: 1980 K/10/MEM/2018 ([click here 1980 K/10/MEM/2018](#))
Date : 2 November 2018
Subject : Harga Indeks Pasar Bahan Bakar Minyak
(Market Index Prices of Oil-Based Fuels)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision Number 1980 K/10/MEM/2018 sets the market index price of premium gasoline based on the average Mean of Platts Singapore (MOPS) published price of Mogas 92 for the preceding three months with a formula 98.42% times the MOPS price for Mogas 92. In addition, the market index price of kerosene shall be based on the average MOPS published price of Jet Kerosene for the preceding three months. The market index price for diesel fuel for determination of the retail selling price of diesel fuel shall be based on the average MOPS published price of Gas Oil 0.25% sulfur for the preceding three months. The period for calculation of these market index prices shall run from the 25th of the month three months earlier through the 24th of the current month for determination of the market index price for the coming three months.

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
