



## Energy & Resources Regulations Update

### The Summary of the New Energy & Resources Regulations

The following is a list of the new energy & resources regulations. All regulations are available in Indonesian.

### New Energy & Resources Regulations

1. Regulation : Presidential Regulation 38/2019 ([click here for Perpres 38/2019](#))  
Date : 12 June 2019  
Regarding : Penyediaan, pendistribusian, dan penetapan harga liquefied petroleum gas untuk kapal penangkap ikan bagi nelayan sasaran dan mesin pompa air bagi petani sasaran  
(Supply, distribution, and pricing of liquefied petroleum gas for fishing vessels for targeted fishermen and water pump machine for targeted farmers)

### **Summary**

Presidential Regulation Number 38 year 2019 regulates the provisions for supply, distribution, and pricing of liquefied petroleum gas for fishing vessels for targeted fishermen and water pump machine for targeted farmers. There is a free starter package given by the government consists of a ship engine, fishing ship converter kit and its installations, 3-kg LPG cylinder including the gas and supporting tools. Meanwhile, the starter package for target famers consists of a water pump, water pump converter kit and its installations, 3-kg LPG cylinder including the gas and supporting tools. The regulation contains requirements for fishermen and

farmers in order for them to get the package; for example for fishermen they are obliged to have fishermen identification card, use environmentally friendly fishing tools, etc. Meanwhile for farmers they are obliged to have the evidence of ownership in the form of certificate of the right to land, farmer identification, etc. This regulation is in force since 17 June 2019.

2. Regulation : Permendag 49/2019 ([click here for Permendag 49/2019](#))  
Date : 24 June 2019  
Regarding : Penetapan harga patokan ekspor atas produk pertambangan yang dikenakan bea keluar  
(Determination of benchmark export prices for mining products subject to export duty)

### **Summary**

Minister of Trade Regulation Number 49 year 2019 covers the benchmark export prices for mining products that are subject to export duty. The regulation stipulates the export price based on the highest average price in international exchanges, FOB (Free On Board), and the highest average price that applies in the domestic market or the highest average price in the last month before the stipulation of the benchmark export price from the importing country from which the mining products come. The benchmark export price in the regulation includes the product's description and its tariff in USD/WE unit. This regulation is in force since 1 July 2019.

3. Regulation : 89/PMK.06/2019 ([click here for 89/PMK.06/2019](#))  
Date : 18 June 2019  
Regarding : Pengelolaan barang milik negara yang berasal dari pelaksanaan kontrak kerja sama kegiatan usaha hulu minyak dan gas bumi  
(Management of state assets originating from the implementation of cooperation contracts for upstream oil and gas business activities)

### **Summary**

Minister of Finance Regulation Number 89/PMK.06/2019 regulates the provisions regarding the goods bought or obtained through an import process for use or intended for use by a contractor in the implementation of upstream oil and gas business activities. These goods are considered as upstream oil and gas state assets after landing at a seaport, airport, or other places in Indonesia and already fulfilled the customs obligations for the purpose of import or use. This regulation consists of requirement planning of the assets, assets utilization, contractors, control units, designation of the usage status of the assets and destruction of assets. This regulation is in force since 19 June 2019.

4. Regulation : Permenperin 20/2019 ([click here for Permenperin 20/2019](#))  
Date : 20 May 2019  
Regarding : Tata cara penerbitan rekomendasi ekspor dan rekomendasi impor bahan bakar lain sebagai bahan baku dan bahan penolong industri  
(Procedures of issuance of export and import recommendation for other fuels as raw materials and industrial auxiliary materials)

### **Summary**

Minister of Industry Regulation Number 20 year 2019 regulates the procedures for issuance of export and import recommendation for other fuels as raw materials and industrial auxiliary materials. This regulation contains the requirements on how to get the export and/or import agreement, requirements to get export recommendation, format of the recommendation letters, reporting, controlling, and other provisions. This regulation is in force since 22 May 2019.

5. Regulation: 24 K/30/MEM/2019 ([click here for 24 K/30/MEM/2019](#))

Date : 6 Feb 2019

Regarding : Perubahan atas Keputusan Menteri Energi dan Sumber Daya Mineral Nomor 1798 K/30/MEM/2018 tentang pedoman pelaksanaan penyiapan, penetapan, dan pemberian wilayah izin usaha pertambangan dan wilayah izin usaha pertambangan khusus mineral dan batubara

(Amendment of Minister of Energy and Resources Decision Number 1798 K/30/MEM/2018 regarding implementation guidelines for preparation, designation, and granting of mining business license areas and special mining business license areas for minerals and coal)

### **Summary**

Minister of Energy and Resources Decision Number 24 K/30/MEM/2019 amended the Minister of Energy and Resources Decision Number 1798 K/30/MEM/2018 regarding implementation guidelines for preparation, designation, and granting of mining business license areas and special mining business license areas for minerals and coal. There are changes in appendix I regarding the requirements for WIUP designation draft. Appendix IX, appendix X are now listed in appendix I, II and III. Appendix XI is no longer exist. This regulation is in force since 6 February 2019.

6. Regulation: 117 K/30/MEM/2019 ([click here for 117 K/30/MEM/2019](#))

Date : 3 July 2019

Regarding : Harga mineral logam acuan dan harga batubara acuan untuk bulan Juli tahun 2019

(Reference prices of metallic minerals and coal for July 2019)

### **Summary**

Minister of Energy and Resources Decision Number 117 K/30/MEM/2019 covers reference prices of metal minerals for 20 types of metals and reference prices for coal as of July 2019. The reference coal price is stipulated at per ton and for metallic minerals prices is stipulated in US\$/dmt. The type of minerals as stated in the regulation including cobalt, lead, zinc, nickel, aluminium and copper. Details of every type of mineral and their prices are all listed in the appendix.

7. Regulation: 116 K/12/MEM/2019 ([click here for 116 K/12/MEM/2019](#))  
Date : 3 July 2019  
Regarding : Penetapan harga minyak mentah Indonesia bulan Juni 2019  
(Determination of Indonesian crude oil prices for June 2019)

### **Summary**

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision Number 116 K/30/MEM/2019 specifically sets the average price of Indonesian crude oil for June 2019 at US\$ 61.00/barrel. This regulation includes the prices of Indonesian crude oil for the main crude oils and other types of crude oil listed in the appendix.
