



Energy & Resources Regulations Update

The Summary of the New Energy & Resources Regulations

The following is a list of the new energy & resources regulations. All regulations are available in Indonesian.

New Energy & Resources Regulations

1. Regulation : [Permen ESDM 20/2019](#)
Date : 18 October 2019
Regarding : Perubahan kedua atas Peraturan Menteri Energi dan Sumber Daya Mineral Nomor 8 Tahun 2017 tentang kontrak bagi hasil gross split
(Second amendment of Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 8 of 2017 concerning gross split production sharing contracts)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 20 of 2019 amended the Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 8 of 2017 concerning Gross Split production sharing contracts. The amendment including a new article namely as Article 25B in between Article 25A and Article 26 concerning the amendment in appendix letter A number 9 concerning domestic component level and appendix letter B number 3 cumulative amount of production for oil and gas. This regulation is in force since 18 October 2019.

2. Regulation : [Permen ESDM 19/2019](#)
Date : 18 October 2019
Regarding : Perubahan ketiga atas Peraturan Menteri Energi dan Sumber Daya Mineral Nomor 28 tahun 2016 tentang tarif tenaga listrik yang disediakan oleh PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero)
(Third amendment of Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation number 28 of 2016 concerning tariff of electric power provided by PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero))

Summary

Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 19 of 2019 amended the Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 28 of 2016 concerning rates of electric power provided by PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara. This regulation amended Article 6 for paragraph 2, paragraph 3, paragraph 5, and a new paragraph between paragraph 3 and paragraph 4, namely paragraph 3a. Article 6 regulates the category of electric power rates. There is also a new article between Article 7 and Article 8, namely Article 7A concerning tariff adjustment for small households. This regulation is in force since 18 October 2019.

3. Regulation : [Permen ESDM 18/2019](#)
Date : 14 October 2019
Regarding : Perubahan atas Peraturan Menteri dan Sumber Daya Mineral Nomor 27 tahun 2017 tentang tingkat mutu pelayanan dan biaya yang terkait dengan penyaluran tenaga listrik oleh PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero)
(Amendment of Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation number 27 of 2017 concerning service quality level and fees associated with distribution of electric power by PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero))

Summary

Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 18 of 2019 amended the Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 27 of 2017 concerning service quality level and fees associated with distribution of electric power by PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara. This regulation amended Article 1 by adding two new paragraphs, namely paragraph 2a and paragraph 2b concerning duration of disruption and compensation for electric power quality service. Article 4 is amended especially in paragraph 4. Article 5 and 6 are also amended, and there are three new articles between Article 6 and 7, namely as Article 6A, Article 6B and Article 6C. In Article 7, they amended both the paragraph 1 and paragraph 2. Last, paragraph 1 in Article 8 is also amended. This regulation will be in force starting on 1 January 2020.

4. Regulation : [Permen ESDM 17/2019](#)
Date : 14 October 2019
Regarding : Perubahan kedua atas Peraturan Menteri Energi dan Sumber Daya Mineral nomor 29 tahun 2016 tentang mekanisme pemberian subsidi tarif tenaga listrik untuk rumah tangga
(Second amendment of Minister of Energy and Resources Number 29 of 2016 concerning the mechanism of provision for electric power subsidies for households)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 17 of 2019 amended the Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 29 of 2016 concerning the mechanism of provision for electric power subsidies for households. The regulation amended Article 6 concerning data verification, Article 7 concerning complaint handling, a new article between Article 8 and Article 9 namely Article 8A that regulates the restitution of excess payment and other new article between Article 10 and Article 11 namely Article 10A concerning consumers of households with electricity power of 900 VA. This regulation is in force since 14 October 2019.

5. Regulation : [**Permen ESDM 16/2019**](#)

Date : 14 October 2019

Regarding : Perubahan kedua atas Peraturan Menteri Energi dan Sumber Daya Mineral nomor 49 tahun 2018 tentang penggunaan sistem pembangkit listrik tenaga surya atap oleh konsumen PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero)
(Second amendment of Minister of Energy and Resources Number 49 of 2018 concerning the use of rooftop solar power generation system by consumers of PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero))

Summary

Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 16 of 2019 amended the Minister of Energy and Resources Regulation Number 49 of 2018 concerning the use of rooftop solar power generation systems by consumers of PT Perusahaan Listrik Negara. This regulation amended Article 14 including the capacity charge for consumers, the formula on how to calculate the amount of charge, the withdrawal of emergency energy charge, etc. There is also a new article between Article 16A and Article 17, namely Article 16B. This regulation is in force since 14 October 2019.

6. Regulation : [**187 K/10/MEM/2019**](#)

Date : 7 October 2019

Regarding : Formula harga dasar dalam perhitungan harga jual eceran jenis bahan bakar minyak umum jenis bensin dan minyak solar yang disalurkan melalui stasiun pengisian bahan bakar umum dan/atau stasiun pengisian bahan bakar nelayan
(Base price formula in calculating retail selling prices for general type oil fuel of gasoline and diesel fuel types distributed through public filling stations and/or fishermen's filling stations)

Summary

This regulation stipulates the calculation of the retail selling prices calculated using the Retail Selling Price formula = MOPS + constants + Margin + VAT (10%) + PBBKB (in accordance with the local Provincial Regulations), where the constants consist of acquisition costs beyond product prices (alpha procurement), storage costs, and distribution costs. The stipulation of the retail selling prices of the General Oil Type by the Business Enterprise also refers to the lower limit provision with the margin calculation as 5% from the base price and the upper limit provision with the margin calculation as 10% from the base price. This regulation will be in

force starting on 1 January 2020 and will revoke the Minister of Energy and Resources Decision Number 19 K/10/MEM/2019.

7. Regulation : [186 K/10/MEM/2019](#)
Date : 7 October 2019
Regarding : Harga mineral logam acuan dan harga batubara acuan untuk bulan Oktober 2019
(Reference prices of metallic minerals and coal for October 2019)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Resources Decision Number 186 K/10/MEM/2019 covers reference prices of metal minerals for 20 types of metals and reference prices for coal as of September 2019. The reference coal price is stipulated at USD/ton. As of October 2019, the reference price for coal is at 64.80 USD/ton. For metallic minerals prices, they are stipulated in US\$/dmt. The types of minerals as stated in the regulation including cobalt, lead, zinc, nickel, aluminium, copper, etc. The reference prices and other details of every type of mineral are all listed in the appendix.

8. Regulation : [185 K/10/MEM/2019](#)
Date : 7 October 2019
Regarding : Penetapan harga minyak mentah Indonesia bulan September 2019
(Determination of Indonesian crude oil prices for September 2019)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision Number 185 K/10/MEM/2019 specifically sets the average price of Indonesian crude oil for September 2019 at US\$ 60.84/barrel. This regulation includes the prices of Indonesian crude oil for the main crude oils and other types of crude oil listed in the appendix. For every type of oil, other than their prices, there are also details concerning their formula, dated brent, and alpha.

9. Regulation : [181 K/30/MEM/2019](#)
Date : 27 September 2019
Regarding : Wilayah izin usaha pertambangan dan wilayah izin usaha pertambangan khusus periode tahun 2019
(Mining business license areas and special mining business license areas for the period of 2019)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision Number 181 K/30/MEM/2018 stipulates the compensation prices for information data and information on land use in Mining Business License Areas and Special Mining Business License Areas, which is needed for implementation of tenders for Mining Business License Areas, and Special Mining Business License Areas in 2019. The compensation for the information data is calculated based on the availability of data and information covering size of the area, type of deposits, status of the area, and loading/transshipment distance. Payment of the compensation price of information data for a

mining area that is tendered must be made in advance. The payment, which is similar to the concept of a signing bonus for an oil and gas work area, applies for 13 mining areas that are tendered.

Regarding : Harga jual eceran jenis bahan bakar minyak tertentu dan jenis bahan bakar minyak khusus penugasan
(Retail selling prices of certain types of oil-based fuels and types of fuels for special assignment)

Summary

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Decision Number 176 K/12/MEM/2019 stipulates the retail selling prices of certain types of oil-based fuels and types of fuels for special assignment. The prices that are stipulated in this regulation including prices for kerosene, diesel oil and gasoline. All the prices are already included with value added tax, and for diesel oil and gasoline are also included with motor vehicle fuel tax.

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
