



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The competition is open to students who are now over 18 years of age and are currently attending and registered at a third level education college in the Republic of Ireland.

2. Entries can be submitted by an individual in an individual's sole name or under one name as a team of no more than 3 people

4. The closing date for receipt of applications is midnight on 20 March 2015. After this date and time, no further entries to the competition will be permitted. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.

5. The judging panel reserves the right (at its sole and absolute discretion) to de-select an application at any stage of the programme. The decision of the judging panel in this regard and in all matters relating to the competition and any decision made will be final and neither the panel nor any member thereof will be compelled to give any reason for any decision made and no correspondence shall be entered into or entertained.

6. Previous entrants who submitted entries in any previous competition(s) and who received funding from Deloitte or another 3<sup>rd</sup> party ( whether received as an individual or as part of a team) shall not be permitted to enter the competition or otherwise may be de-selected by the judging panel ( at its sole and absolute discretion) under clause number 4 above.

7. Shortlisted candidates/groups will be invited to attend a "development day" on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2015 at the end of which candidates will perform a 5 minute elevator pitch Candidates/groups must attend this day in order to qualify for the final event day.

8. On 9<sup>th</sup> April 2015 there will be a final where a further shortlist will present their ideas to the judging panel

9. The winning individual or group will be announced on the day of the final presentations

The prize will be a trip to a Deloitte Digital studio in North America valued to a maximum of €5000 (Five thousand Euro only) including VAT comprising of return travel fares, transport to and from the airport to the hotel, accommodation in a 3 or 4 star hotel for 2 nights with bed and breakfast, evening meal and spending money.

The winning entry (individual or team) will also receive a place on the Deloitte Ireland summer internship program.
