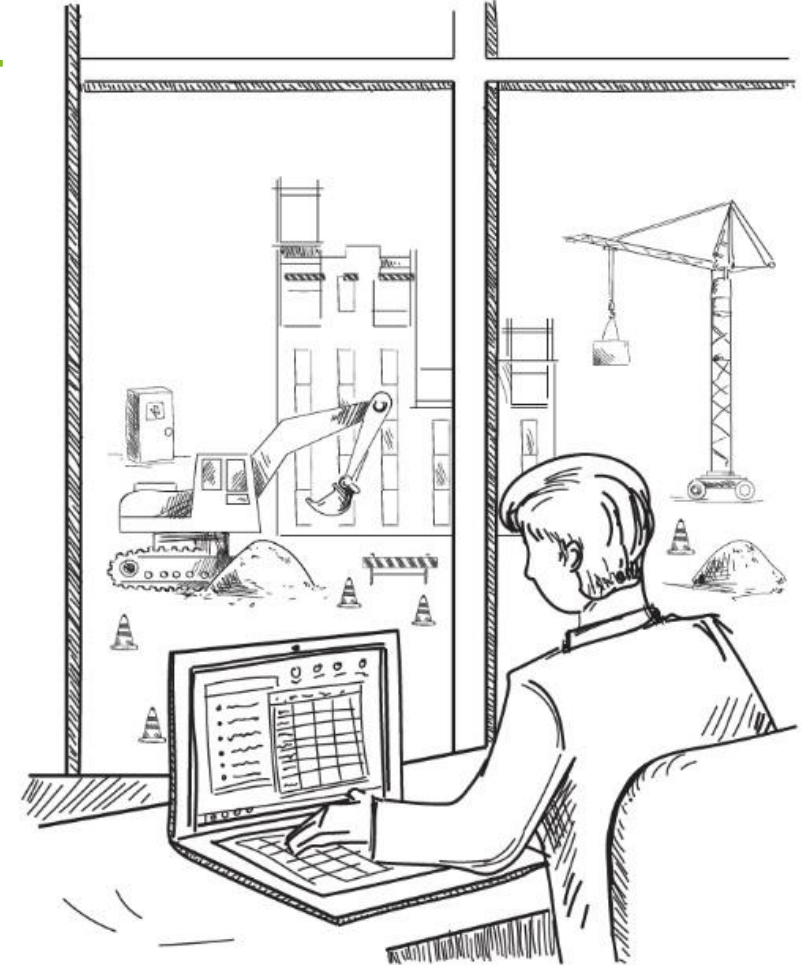

Industry risks

Construction has always been a high risk industry. Industrial accident rates in the industry are very high.

H&S activities are often reduced to the signing of accident prevention training logs. This sort of attitude should not be tolerated, as it may lead to tragic consequences and pose significant risks for the entire project.

Non-compliance with safety regulations is an administrative offense (Article 5.27.1 of the Russian Administrative Code). An employer may be liable to monetary and non-monetary penalties including:



Trauma caused by equipment failure and electrical shock



Falling from height during high-rise operations



Structural failures and falling objects



Disqualification of officers



Suspension from business activity



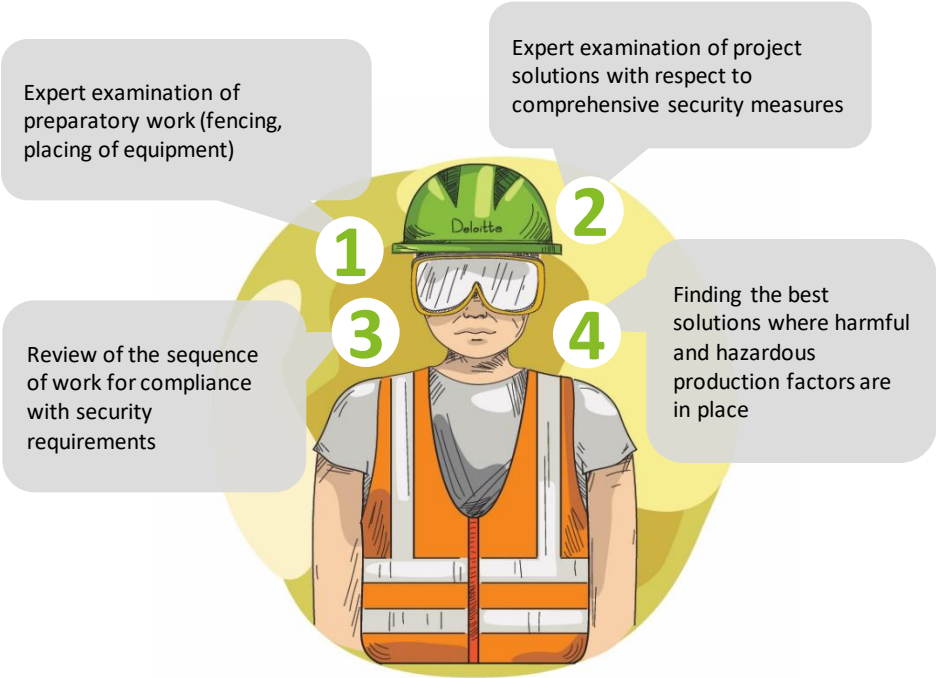
Imprisonment of the responsible official for up to four years

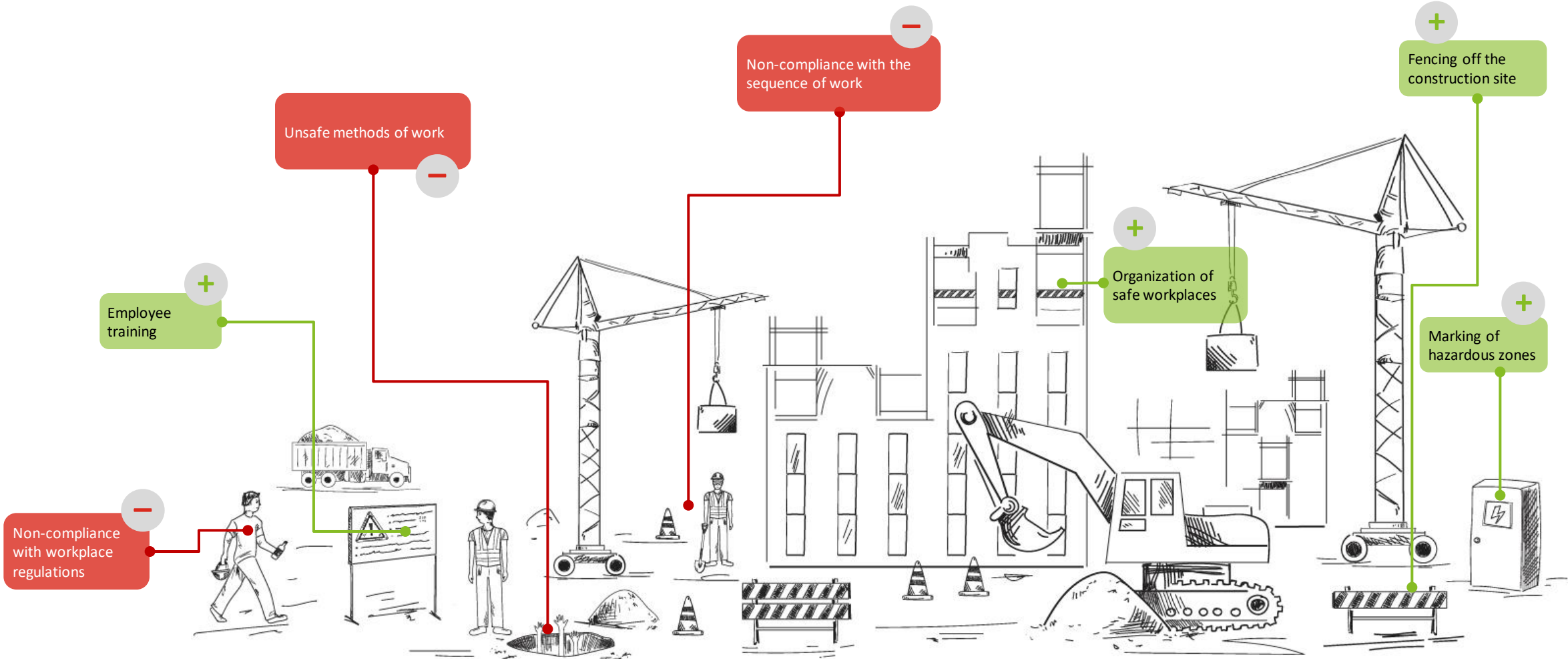
