Building a career starts during your studies—not after

Based on the tremendous success of the Open Days of Deloitte Luxembourg's Advisory & Consulting Group (ACG) in 2014, a second version was organized this year on 26 and 27 November.

More than 300 students from leading business schools and universities in Luxembourg, France, Belgium, Switzerland, Germany, the UK, Ireland and the Netherlands were asked to submit their application. After screening, 71 were invited to join the one-and-a-half-day event in Luxembourg.

During their stay, the students did get a chance to attend several workshops on various consulting topics, meet professionals and partners from the different departments and got introduced to the multilingual and multicultural environment in Luxembourg – a key differentiating opportunity for young people seeking to develop an international career.

“Today’s students are the leaders of tomorrow. As one of the premier career destinations for young professionals, we need to show these students how they can actively shape their careers and make an impact that matters”, explains Benjamin Collette, Partner and Talent & Innovation leader at Deloitte Luxembourg. “We want to show today’s talent how they can create an interesting and challenging career at Deloitte, and that starts during their studies—not after graduation”.

Last year’s Open Days welcomed more than 80 students, of which more than 20 percent were offered an open-term contract after graduation from their respective schools.

Carrière: tout se joue pendant les études

Suite au succès phénoménal des journées portes ouvertes organisées par l' Advisory & Consulting Group (ACG) de Deloitte Luxembourg en 2014, celles-ci ont été reconduites cette année, les 26 et 27 novembre.

Plus de 300 étudiants des principales écoles de commerce et universités du Luxembourg, de France, de Belgique, de Suisse, d'Allemagne, du Royaume-Uni, d'Irlande et des Pays-Bas ont été invités à déposer leur dossier. À l'issue de la phase de sélection, 71 d'entre eux ont été conviés à l'événement organisé pendant un jour et demi au Luxembourg.

Au cours de leur séjour, les étudiants ont eu la possibilité de participer à de nombreux ateliers abordant diverses questions relatives au domaine du conseil, de rencontrer des professionnels et des associés des différents départements et de découvrir l'environnement multilingue et multiculturel du Luxembourg; un atout majeur pour des jeunes désireux d'entreprendre une carrière internationale.

« Les étudiants d'aujourd'hui sont les dirigeants de demain. En tant qu'employeur très prisé par les jeunes professionnels, nous devons montrer à ces étudiants qu'ils peuvent façonner leur carrière activement et se démarquer positivement » explique Benjamin Collette, Partner et Talent and Innovation leader chez Deloitte Luxembourg. *« Nous souhaitons aider les talents d'aujourd'hui à construire une carrière intéressante et ambitieuse chez Deloitte. Ceci se fait déjà pendant leurs études, pas seulement une fois le diplôme en poche ».*
