On October 14th 2016, the European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) published its Final guidelines on sound remuneration policies under the UCITS Directive and the AIFMD.

The provisions reported in the given guidelines correspond to those reported in ESMA's Final Report published on March 31st 2016.

These guidelines will enter into force as of January 1st 2017.
