Application questionnaire to set up a SIF or UCI Part II or SICAR

CSSF introduces a new form of questionnaire to be used for the filing of a SIF, UCI Part II, or SICAR project

Background

On 15 February 2017, the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier (CSSF) published an update of its new form of "Application Questionnaire to set up a SIF or UCI Part II or SICAR."

This application form is used to collect all the information required by the CSSF for the purpose of its review and authorization process.

The submission process itself remains unchanged (secure channels or email setup.uci@cssf.lu), except that for applications filed through email, specific naming conventions need to be respected.

Transition:

The new form is immediately available. However you will be able to continue to use previous formats for any application filed before 15 March 2017. After this date, the use of the new application form will be mandatory for any new submission.
