



Training Integrated- and Sustainability Reporting for Internal Auditors, Finance and Sustainability managers

The importance of non-financial information is growing rapidly. Many organizations are now reporting, or want to report, along GRI (G4) guidelines and/or the Integrated Reporting Framework. However, many are not sure where to start or how all the different non-financial reporting guidelines come together. Additionally, while reporting on non-financial information is advancing quickly, internal controls associated with this information are often not maturing at the same pace. Companies are starting to ask themselves how to create non-financial internal controls that are as robust as financial ones.

The training

During this training you will be introduced to, or learn more about, the Global Reporting Initiative, the International Integrated Reporting Framework and how these reports align with other standards and guidelines you may be familiar with. After this training you will have a better understanding of how non-financial reporting contributes to value creation for the business, what is necessary for Integrated and/or GRI reporting, and how you can improve the reliability (internal controls) of these reports.

The training will be given from an 'Internal Control'-perspective. It is relevant not only for internal auditors, but also for financial and sustainability managers that are concerned with preparing an Integrated or GRI Report.

- Assessing materiality and stakeholder involvement to define report content;

- Assurance Standards and Assurance Process.
