



Training Integrated- and Sustainability Reporting for Internal Auditors, Finance and Sustainability managers

The importance of non-financial information is growing rapidly and from 2017 onwards listed companies are required to report specific information regarding environmental issues and other non-financial information. Many organizations are currently reporting about sustainability and other non-financial issues. However, many are not sure where to start or how all the different non-financial reporting guidelines come together. Additionally, it is unclear which framework for reporting (GRI G4 of Integrated Reporting Framework) is most suitable, what are the similarities between those frameworks. Furthermore, which performance indicators are relevant, how is relevant information gathered within the organization and how is the quality assured?

The training

During this training you will be introduced to, or learn more about, the Global Reporting Initiative, the International Integrated Reporting Framework and how these reports align with other standards and guidelines you may be familiar with. After this training you will have a better understanding of how non-financial reporting contributes to value creation for the business, what is necessary for Integrated and/or GRI reporting, and how you can improve the reliability (internal controls) of these reports.

Who should attend?

The training will be given from an 'Internal Control'-perspective. It is relevant not only for internal auditors, but also for financial and sustainability managers that are concerned with preparing an Integrated or GRI Report.

The training will address the following topics:

- Value of non-financial reporting and the non-financial reporting landscape;
- The Framework for Integrated Reporting;
- GRI G4 Guidelines and process for defining report content;
- Assessing materiality and stakeholder involvement to define report content;
- Value of Sustainability Assurance;
- Data management and internal controls for non-financial information;
- Assurance Standards and Assurance Process.
