What will you be doing?

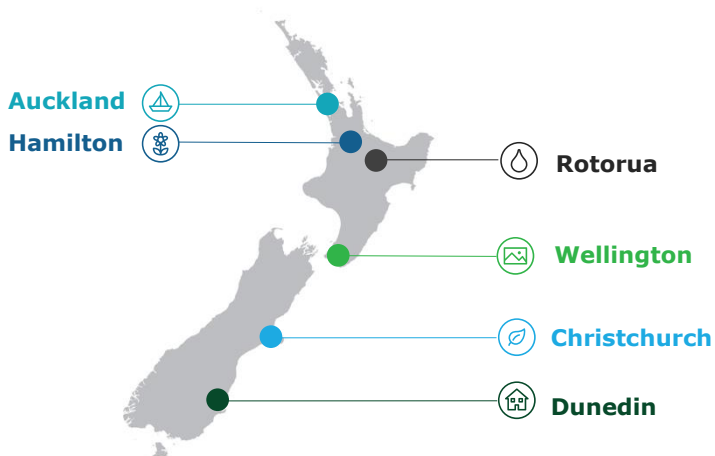
- Analysis and preparation of management accounts and annual financial statements
