On 4 August 2014, Federal Law No. 142-FZ “On amendments to Articles 6 and 30 of the Federal Law ‘On Russian citizenship’ and some other legislative acts” (hereinafter, the Law) came into effect. The Law sets out the responsibility for Russian citizens to disclose whether they hold any foreign citizenship, residence permit or any other document entitling its holder to permanent residence in a foreign country.

The approved form and the procedure for disclosure were published yesterday (please refer to the attached file). Failure to disclose will result in administrative or criminal liability. The deadline for notification without penalty is 2 October 2014.
