Protocol on issues related to the import and circulation of goods within the EEU customs territory passed through committee

The Russian Legislative Drafting Commission has approved the draft federal law “On ratification of the Protocol on some issues related to the import and circulation of goods within the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union.” Under the Protocol, Kazakhstan will be obligated to prevent goods registered at discounted customs rates from being exported to other EEU member countries. The Protocol also sets a general turnover procedure for the goods to which Kazakhstan must apply a reduced customs rate pursuant to its obligations to the WTO, and envisions a mechanism for administering and overseeing the turnover of such goods.
