The Russian President has signed a package of federal laws, namely:

- Federal Law No. [401-FZ](#) of 30 November 2016 addressing the implementation of the national fiscal roadmap (for details, please refer to LT of 29 November 2016);
- Federal Law No. [405-FZ](#) changing the procedure for calculating limits for doubtful debt provisions generated at the end of a reporting period;
- Federal Law No. [408-FZ](#) of 30 November 2016 easing the restrictions on the permitted advertising space in periodicals for the purposes of applying the beneficial 10-percent VAT rate (for details, please refer to LT of [10 October 2016](#)).

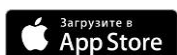
