### **Draft law levying tolls on heavy goods vehicles using regional and inter-municipal roads**

The Russian State Duma is considering Draft Law No. 1126740-6, which would levy a toll on vehicles with a gross weight rating exceeding 12 tonnes for the use of public regional and inter-municipal roads. The new toll collection system would be similar to the Platon system.

The Platon system was launched on 15 November 2015. The effective rate of the road toll charged for the use of federal roads is RUB 1.53 per kilometre.

### **Draft law introducing state monopoly on alcohol production and distribution**

The Russian State Duma is reviewing Draft Law No. 1130095-6, which would introduce a state monopoly on the production and/or distribution of ethanol, alcoholic beverages and products containing alcohol with effect from 1 January 2017.

The document stipulates that only state-owned companies shall be authorised to produce and distribute ethanol, alcoholic beverages and products containing alcohol.

It should be noted that a similar draft law (No. [1031799-6](#)) was submitted to the State Duma in March 2016 (for more details, please refer to LT of [31 March 2016](#)). To date, the status of this draft law has not changed.

### **Russia may create information system on food production**

Russian authorities plan to create a dedicated information system that would help to track food production data (e.g. place of origin, additives used, etc.).

The system will be available from mobile devices.

The information system is expected to be part of the Strategy for the Improvement of Food Product Quality approved by the Russian Government in June 2016 (for more details, please refer to LT of [16 March 2016](#)).
