Amendments to Russia-Singapore DTA signed

Representative from Russia and Singapore have signed a protocol amending the countries' double taxation agreement. The protocol, signed on 17 November, introduces amendments that specify the criteria for creating permanent establishments, and alter certain taxation provisions for dividends, interest and royalties. The amendments will come into effect after the protocol is ratified by both countries. The original double taxation agreement between Russia and Singapore was signed on 9 September 2002.
