Reducing the list of documents for customs declaration of goods

This Order reduces the list of documents submitted for customs declaration of goods placed under a customs export procedure and not subject to export customs duties. In particular, it cancels the obligation to report transport (shipping) documents. The Order comes into force 30 days from the date of its official publication.
