### **Extension of beneficial insurance premiums for IT companies proposed**

The Russian Ministry of Economic Development is preparing a federal law envisaging the retention of beneficial insurance premiums for IT companies. The document has been sent to the Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Labour for approval.

The text of the draft law has not been officially published.
