### **Procedure for registering a trademark or symbol used as a trademark as a trademark generally recognised in the RF**

RF Ministry of Economic Development Order No. 602 of 27 August 2015 has approved the Administrative Regulations for the Federal Intellectual Property Service's provision of state services on registering trademarks or symbols used as trademarks as trademarks generally recognised in the RF. In particular, the document sets out the possible applicants, the time periods for the provision of state services, the list of documents to be submitted, the basis for refusing documents and others.

### **Possible amendments to the procedure for considering cases challenging acts containing legislative clarifications and having normative qualities**

It is reported that draft law No. 892355-6 "On the Introduction of Amendments to the RF Administrative Legal Proceedings Code (as Regards the Procedure for the Consideration of Cases Challenging Certain Acts in the Courts)" has been introduced to the RF State Duma for consideration. In particular, it stipulates that cases challenging acts of federal executive authorities with normative qualities and containing legislative clarifications are to be considered by the RF Supreme Court as the court of first instance, in accordance with the rules envisaged for proceedings on cases challenging normative legal regulations and in the manner envisaged by Chapter 21 of the RF Administrative Legal Proceedings Code with a number of special considerations envisaged by this draft law. If the draft law is adopted, the federal law will enter into force one month from the moment of its official publication. Furthermore, draft law No. [892365-6](#) has been introduced to the RF State Duma, which sets the state duty for filing an administrative legal claim challenging an act with normative qualities and containing legislative clarifications at RUB 300 for individuals and RUB 4,500 for legal entities.

### **Possible amendments to the legal regulation of state support for exports**

It is reported that the RF Ministry of Economic Development is developing a draft Federal Law “On Support for Export in the Russian Federation”. In particular, this draft law describes functions of the state authorities and organisations providing state support for exports and establishes measures of financial and non-financial support for exports. If adopted, the Federal Law will enter into force 90 days from its official publication.

### **Possible amendments to credit organisation procedures for accounting income and expenses**

It is reported that the Central Bank of Russia is preparing a draft Statement “On the Introduction of Amendments to Central Bank of Russia Regulation No. 446-P of 22 December 2014 “On the Procedure for Determining the Income, Expenses and Other Aggregate Income of Credit Organisations”. In particular, amendments are planned relating to the accounting for currency exchange and conversion operations, purchase and sale of precious metals, repurchase transactions, fee-based income and more. At the moment, the draft Statement is undergoing anti-corruption evaluation. Please note that Central Bank of Russia Regulation No. 446-P of 22 December 2014 enters into force on 1 January 2016.

It is reported that the RF Ministry of Economic Development has submitted a [draft law](#) “On the Introduction of Amendments to the Federal Law ‘On Insolvency (Bankruptcy)’ and Certain RF Legislative Acts (as Regards Regulating Issues Relating to the Application of Monitoring and Financial Restructuring Procedures)” for the consideration of the RF Government. The main aim of the draft law is to extend the practice of applying financial restructuring procedures.

It is reported that the Moscow City Government has prepared proposals on the sale of plots of land designated for industry and has established an

information service on vacant plots in technopoleis and technoparks. In particular, information on the plots of land for sale and those being prepared for sale, on their location, designation, technical-economic characteristics, transport links, and the preliminary cost of connecting them to utilities is available on the Moscow Unified Informational Investment Portal under the section "[Industrial Plots](#)". Information on plots; their designations; the characteristics of buildings; floor plans and photographs of the property items; and the characteristics of technoparks, including information on the access to utilities, the cost of connection to utilities, tax benefits and available equipment has been made available under the section "[Technoparks](#)" for investors engaged in high-tech projects and interested in opening businesses in technoparks and technopoleis in Moscow.
