



Deloitte Scholarship 2016

Application guide and FAQs

1. Who is eligible for the scholarship?

The scholarship is open to all undergraduates studying Accountancy who have completed their first academic year and are starting their second year in August 2016.

2. What is the value of the scholarship?

The successful candidate will be provided with financial support per academic year for year two, year three and year four if the student is doing the honours year. The student will also be offered two internships at Deloitte.

3. What do you look for in considering the scholarship application?

We take a holistic view of the candidate's academic excellence, overall development and track record in co-curricular activities, as well as his/her interest in the pursuing a career in Audit & Advisory, Risk Advisory or Tax.

4. Will I be required to maintain a certain GPA score for the duration of my course?

We expect our scholars to do well consistently. If however, the scholar has failed to maintain academic standards, we may discontinue the scholarship grant, but this will not be retroactive.

5. Will I be required to do a compulsory internship with the firm?

We strongly encourage our scholars to complete an internship with the firm. We would also extend an invitation to our scholars to return for a 2nd internship to gain experience in a different service line.

6. Will there be an obligatory service after I graduate?

You will be obliged to serve the firm for two years upon graduation. If you have received the scholarship in your honours year as well this will be extended to three years' service.

7. Will I be able to choose the service line after graduation?

Our scholars will primarily start their career in our Audit & Advisory, Risk Advisory or Tax service lines. Requests to transfer to another service line will be considered after a two year period.

8. What is the selection process?

The applicants will be scheduled and shortlisted for an interview by a panel of interviewers. The timeline is as follows:
