

Hong Kong

Suspension of passenger flights from the United Kingdom (UK)

Government of the Hong Kong special administrative region (SAR) | 28 June 2021

With effect from 12.00 a.m. (HKT) on 1 July 2021, all passenger flights from the UK will be prohibited from landing in Hong Kong. The UK will also be specified as an extremely high-risk group A1 specified place, and persons who have stayed there for more than two hours will be prohibited from boarding passenger flights for Hong Kong.

Latest updates on quarantine requirements

Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare | 28 June 2021

Returnees and entrants from the following regions will be subject to a COVID-19 test upon arrival, a quarantine period in government-designated facilities, and additional COVID-19 testing according to the following schedule. If they test negative for all of their relevant COVID-19 tests, they may leave the government-designated facility, but must remain at home for the remainder of the 14-day period:

- **COVID-19 tests on the third, sixth, and 10th day of entry:** Returnees and entrants from Afghanistan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka.
- **COVID-19 tests on the third and sixth day of entry:** Returnees and entrants from Bangladesh, Egypt, Indonesia, Malaysia, Uganda, and the United Kingdom.
- **COVID-19 test on the third day of entry :** Returnees and entrants from Belgium, Brazil, Canada (Ontario only), Denmark, Estonia, France, Greece, Ireland, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz, Latvia, Netherlands, Nigeria, Peru, Philippines, Portugal, Russia (i.e., Moscow city, Moscow oblast, and St. Petersburg city only), South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Luxembourg, Thailand, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, the United States (i.e., Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Idaho, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, and Washington only), and Vietnam.

All other returnees and entrants will be tested for COVID-19 upon arrival. If they test negative, they will then be required to remain at home for the full 14-day quarantine

period.


