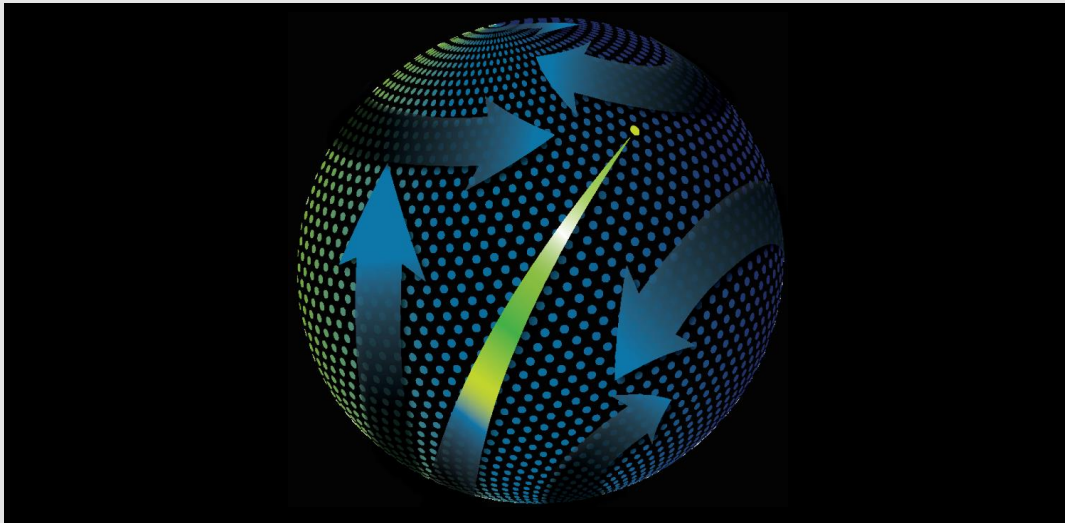

Australia to lift outbound travel ban for vaccinated residents from 1 November 2021

All fully vaccinated citizens and permanent residents will be able to leave Australia without a special exemption from 1 November 2021, as restrictions are eased amidst a rise in vaccination rates.

Government to resume quarantine exemption arrangement for persons arriving from Macao

Government of the Hong Kong special administrative region (SAR) | 28 October 2021

The quarantine exemption arrangement for persons arriving from Macao under the Return2hk scheme and the Come2hk scheme will resume from 2 November 2021. However, these travellers would still be subject to multiple compulsory tests under the established requirements of the schemes. They should also exercise self-monitoring of their health conditions for at least 14 days after entry, and abide by the health-monitoring checklist.

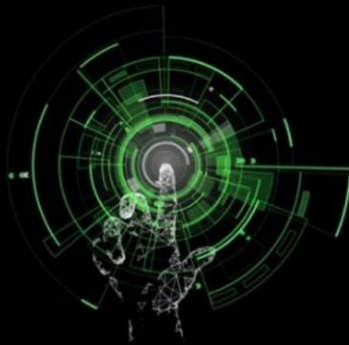
