


EU Deforestation Regulation

Prepare for new regulatory requirements affecting companies that market or supply specific commodities and products within the European Union, or export them from the EU.

What is EUDR?

The European Union Deforestation Regulation is a regulation for companies trading in the EU in commodities such as wood, rubber, cattle, cocoa, coffee, soya and palm oil, or products made from them, such as tires, furniture, chocolate, leather, clothing and clothing accessories made from natural rubber, paper packaging and pallets (where the product is a stand-alone product and not a packaging material used solely to support, protect or transport another marketed product), etc. The regulation requires companies to demonstrate that their products do not cause deforestation, are produced in accordance with the legislation of the country of production and have the necessary due diligence statements.





Which companies are affected by EUDR and from when?

EUDR applies to anyone who imports, exports or distributes relevant goods in the EU in the course of business.

30 Dec 2024

applies to large and medium-sized enterprises

30 Jun 2025

applies to smaller enterprises



What are the potential sanctions for non-compliance with the EUDR?

Companies face, for example, **financial penalties** (up to 4% of the company's total annual turnover), **confiscation of the products concerned**, exclusion from public procurement and access to public funding, temporary **bans on the marketing of relevant products and commodities** and more.
