How to Use 'Luna' Wireless Speaker

Pairing & using Luna

- 1. Press and hold the power button for 3 sec to power Luna on. You will hear a startup chime. The indicator light will begin flashing blue to indicate that you are in Pairing Mode. (Note: If Luna is not paired within 5 minutes, the Luna will automatically turn off.)
- 2. Enter the Settings in your phone/device. Find your Bluetooth settings.
- 3. You should see Luna in the list of nearby Bluetooth devices. If you do not see Luna listed, make sure the Luna light is flashing to indicate that it is in Pairing Mode.
- 4. From the list of devices, tap Luna. Once paired, you will hear two beeps indicating a successful pairing and the indicator light will stop flashing.
- 5. Play your favorite tunes on Luna!
- 6. Press the power button once to pause/resume music or hold for 3 seconds to turn Luna off. (Note: Luna, like all Bluetooth" devices can only be paired to one phone/device at a time. To pair Luna with a new phone/device, you must first disconnect the phone/device it is currently paired with. You can do this by 1) turning off this device's Bluetooth, 2) forgetting Luna as a paired speaker in this device's Bluetooth settings, or 3) taking this device out of Bluetooth range of Luna.)

Recharging Luna

When your speaker is running low on battery, insert the micro USB end of the included charging cable into the charging port of Luna. Insert the USB end of the cable into a USB power source (computer, USB charger, etc.). While charging, the indicator light on the Luna will be red.

Troubleshooting

If you have paired your phone to both Luna speakers instead of pairing the second Luna to the first Luna, the surround sound will not work.

Here is how to correct this:

- 1. Enter your phone's Settings and turn the Bluetooth off. both be flashing blue.
- 2. Turn on both Lunas. Their indicator lights should both be flashing blue.
- 3. On each of the Lunas, double-click the middle button. This activates Surround Mode.
- 4. You will hear a chime when the speakers pair with each other.
- 5. Turn your phone's Bluetooth back on and pair to just one of the Lunas.
- 6. Now you can play audio in surround sound.

Using the speakerphone

While your speaker is playing music and you receive a phone call, you will hear the ring through Luna. You can press the answer button on the Luna to pick up the phone call. When you are done, press the same button again and hang up phone calls using your smartphone.

Pairing a second Luna for surround sound

A Luna can connect to a second Luna for surround sound. If you have a second Luna, follow the below instructions to pair it to the first:

- 1. Turn both Lunas on by pressing their power buttons.
- 2. Double click the power button on both Lunas (it does not have to be on the same time). You will hear a beep from both Lunas.
- 3. Wait about 10 seconds and the Lunas will pair to each other. You will hear a double-beep.
- 4. Enter the Bluetooth settings on your phone/device and connect to Luna. You will hear a double-beep confirming the Lunas have paired to your phone.
