The diagnostic tool reviews the transformation and change agenda against existing and upcoming future regulation.

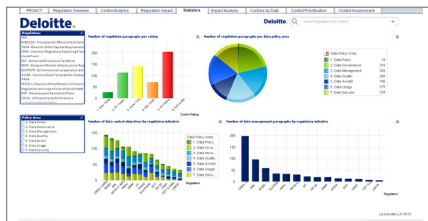

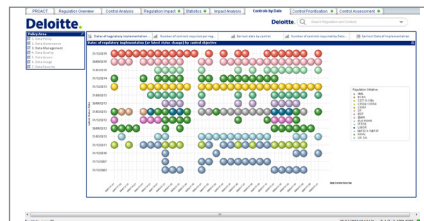
