


Planning for the wind down of the 2012 Olympic Games (ongoing)

The situation

The London Organising Committee for the Olympic Games approached us to assist in the planning and implementation of the wind down of the group structure, after the 2012 Olympic Games.

The two risks facing us were the financial and reputational factors arising from the wind down of the group structure.
