2014 Carl. H. Lindner Award for Entrepreneurial and Civic Spirit



The tenth annual Carl H. Lindner Award for Entrepreneurial and Civic Spirit is being presented to a business leader who personifies the leadership, business success, and civic involvement which was characterized by Carl Lindner in our community. As we continue to celebrate the life and accomplishments of Mr. Lindner, we are very pleased to present the 2014 recipient of the Carl H. Lindner Award for Entrepreneurial and Civic Spirit to Mr. Jeff Wyler.

Jeff Wyler is the Chairman and CEO of the Jeff Wyler Automotive Family, the company he founded in 1973 as a Chevrolet dealership. The company has grown from the one Chevrolet location in Batavia to 15 locations in Ohio, Indiana, and Kentucky representing 15 different makes. Sales have grown from 200 cars per year to more than 35,000 in 2014, and his service departments repair more than 300,000 vehicles each year. His original 12 employees have increased to nearly 1,400, and The Jeff Wyler Automotive Family was listed by Automotive News in 2013 as the 53rd largest automotive retailer in the country.

Jeff Wyler also serves as Chairman of the Board of CBank, a commercial bank located in Montgomery, that he co-founded in 2007. He was previously a member of the Board of Directors of Bank One Cincinnati and he also previously served on the Board of Trustees of the University of Cincinnati for nine years; three of those years as Chairman. Currently he is a member of the Board of Trustees of The Cincinnati Art Museum and UC Health.

In 2006, he became a minority partner in the Cincinnati Reds, for whom he sold tickets to pay his way through college. He was elected into the Greater Cincinnati Northern Kentucky Business Hall of Fame in 2010, and is a member of the Commercial Club of Cincinnati. From 2005 to 2008 he owned and operated a NASCAR Truck racing team that won three races including Daytona in 2007.

Mr. Wyler and his wife Linda have four children, three of which are active in the business, and six grandchildren.
