Interested in applying? Here's the process:

- Students should apply for admission to any of the seven designated school's fifth-year master's program for the 2022-2023 academic year and separately apply for the Deloitte Foundation scholarship.
- The University will select tuition scholarship recipients.
- Upon notification and acceptance, the selected school will discount your tuition by 50% (or an equivalent contribution), and the Deloitte Foundation will cover the remaining 50% (excluding books and living expenses).
