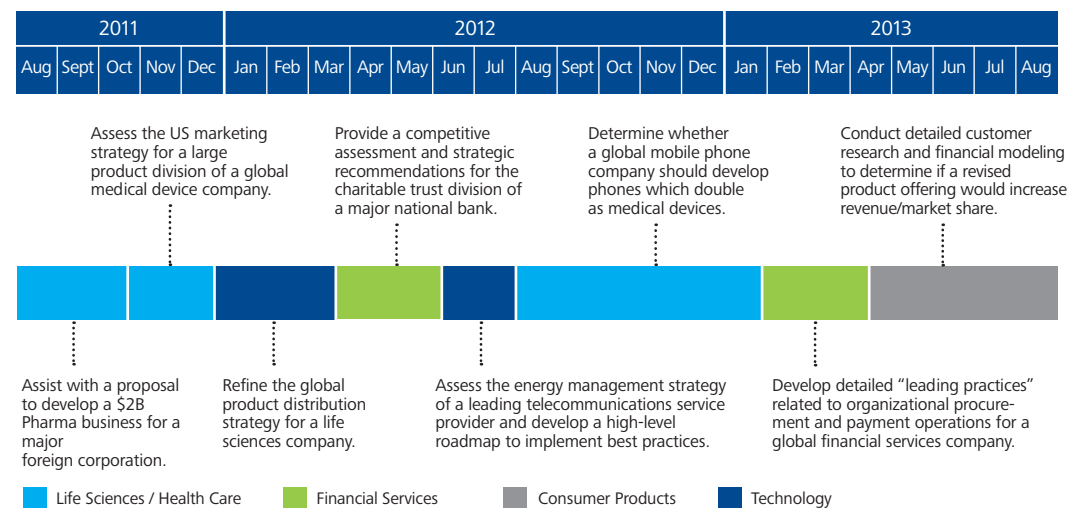
Go forward.
