



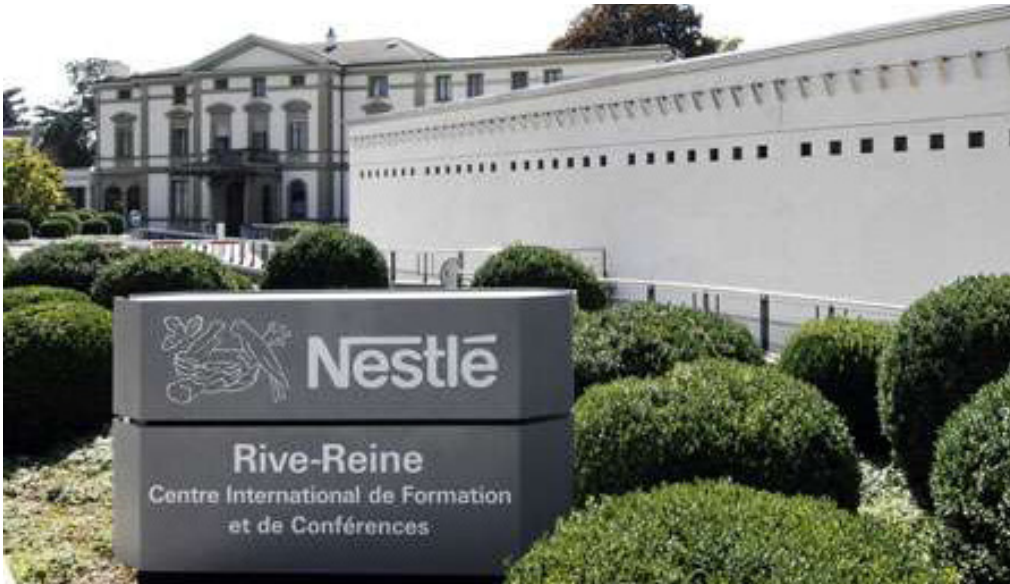

Airport

The closest airport to reach Rive-Reine is Geneva-Airport.



Parking

Train journey from Geneva Airport to Vevey takes approximately one hour. Round-trip ticket costs approx. CHF. 110.00 (1st class) and CHF. 62.00 (2nd class). Follow signs indicate "Gare CFF" at Geneva Airport.

From Vevey train station, take a taxi to Rive-Reine (La Tour-de-Peilz). It is at approx. 5 minutes by taxi from Vevey station.

If you travel by car, underground parking places are available in the Rive-Reine Training Centre building (level -2).



By Car – Highway

- From Geneva-Airport, take the highway direction Lausanne, then Vevey.
- Exit Vevey, then follow Vevey to a first roundabout, follow "La Tour-de-Peilz" (Centre)
- Going down towards the lake. Rive-Reine is to the east of La Tour-de-Peilz (main road Vevey-Montreux).

By Car – Lake Road

- Coming from Lausanne, take the first roundabout in Vevey in front of the Nestlé building direction "Montreux".
- Passing in front of Nestlé Switzerland (Entre-deux-Villes – La Tour-de-Peilz)
- Rive-Reine is about 1km in the direction of Montreux on your right (lake side).



By Train

Dress Code

Fitness:

The 'La Tour Fitness Club' is located in La Tour de Peilz, 5 minutes walking distance from Rive-Reine. Please ask the Rive-Reine Residence Front Desk for more information.

Jogging/Swimming:

For those who enjoy jogging and a dip in the lake, you can jog along the lakeside promenade all the way to Vevey! The lake is clean and perfect for swimming in summer.

For your WiFi connection, please get your personal User ID + Password from the Receptions of Rive-Reine Residence or Training Center.

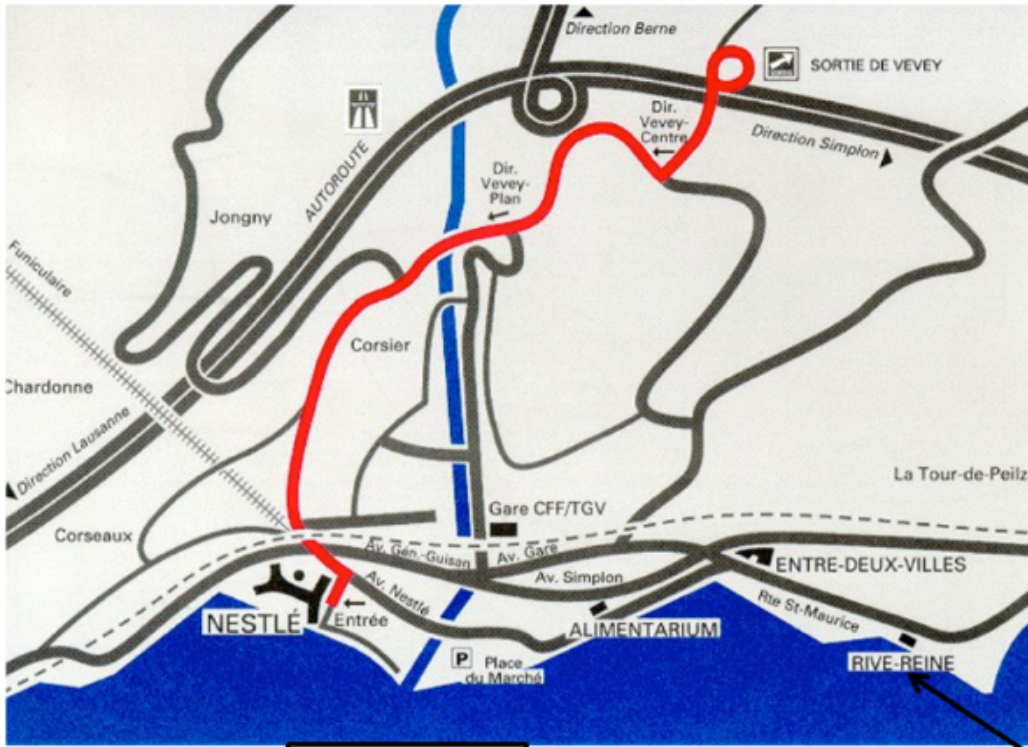


**Members of your family
