

## GSA Alliant Program Overview

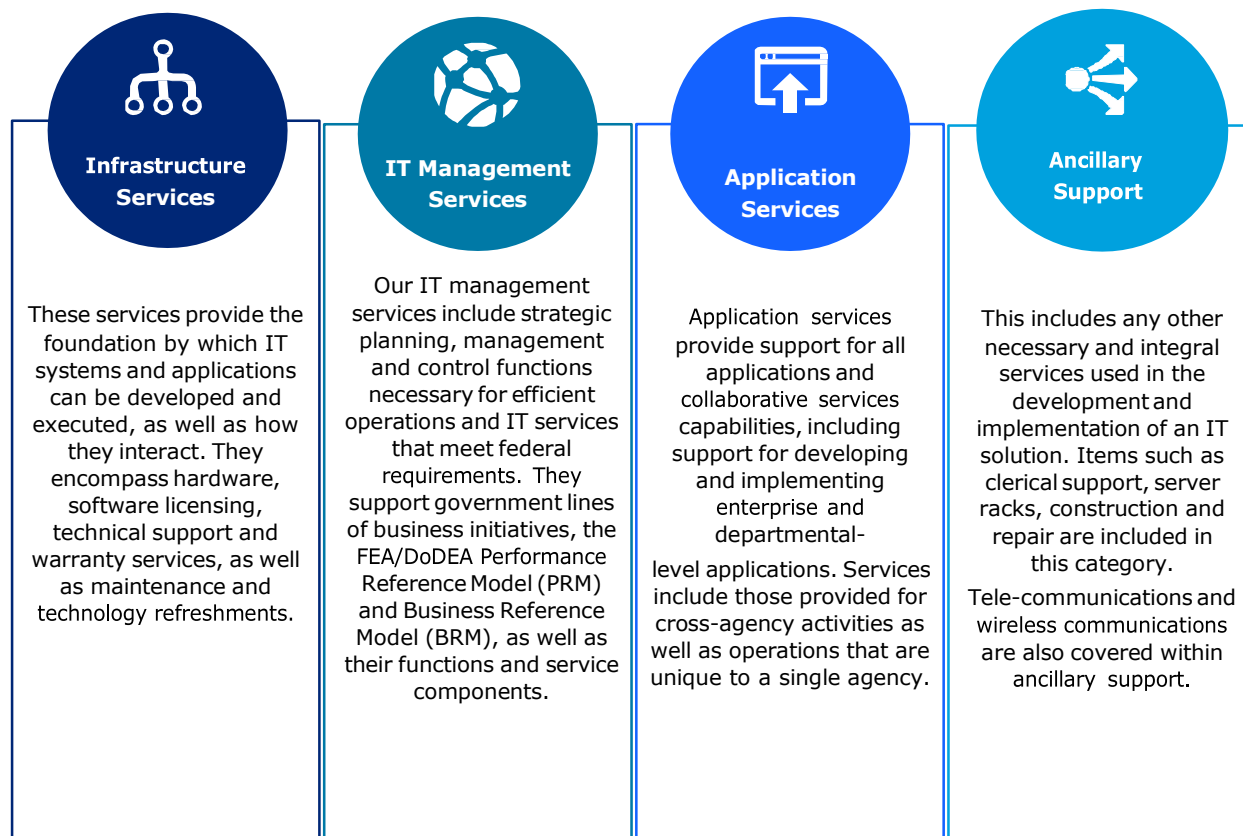
### What is Alliant?

The period of performance for the Alliant contract is May 1, 2009 to April 30, 2019.
