Claims	Reserved Claim Count	The number of claims that have been reported with a reserve allocated.	The sum of claims that have been reported with a reserve allocated during a given time period.
Operations Policy Admin	Policies in Force Count	Number of active policies	Count of in-force policy active policies to analyze the source of how a policy is created. The information can be used to enhance channel strategies of the insurance company.
Underwriting Product Management	Product mix	Divide the written premium of each product to find the allocation of the product mix	Percentage composition of products within an organization's entire product portfolio measured by policies or contracts in force and/or

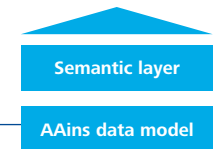
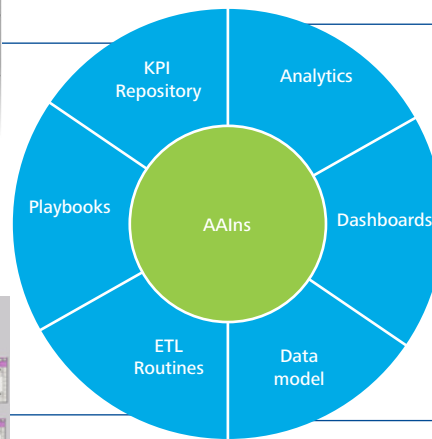
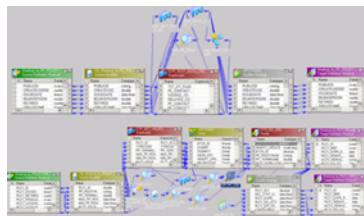
