01 失业保险基金的现金津贴以支持受 COVID-19 疫情影响的员工



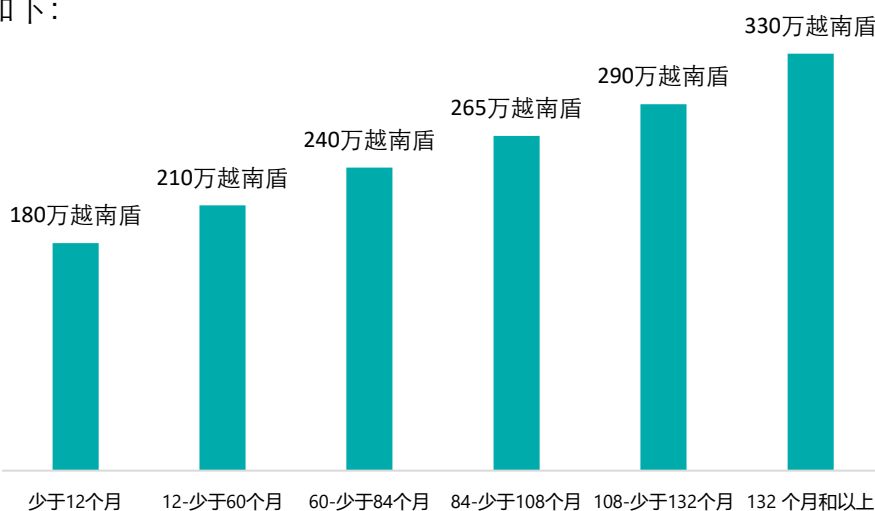
对象:

- 正在参加失业保险截至 **2021 年 9 月 30 日*** 的员工
- 从 **2020 年 1 月 1 日至 2021 年 9 月 30 日** 期间因劳动合同或工作合同终止而停止参加失业保险 并根据就业法规定的失业保险缴费期限得以保留的员工，不包括每月领取养老金收入的员工。



津贴:

津贴水平以职工缴纳失业保险金的时间为基准，不包括已领取失业津贴的时间，具体如下：

执行时间表:

自 **2021 年 10 月 1 日** 起至 **2021 年 12 月 31 日** 完成。

02 降低受 Covid-19 疫情影响的雇主对失业保险基金的缴费率



对象:

根据就业法第 43 条规定于 **2021 年 10 月 1 日前*** 参加失业保险的雇主。



缴费率降低:

1%

0%

允许雇主将其对失业保险的缴费率从应缴纳失业保险的雇员月薪的 **1%** 降至 **0%**。



执行时间表:

12个月：从 **2021 年 10 月 1 日** 至 **2022 年 9 月 30 日**。
