The International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (ITAC) calls for public comments on whether to terminate or extend the policy directive on the exportation of ferrous and non-ferrous waste and scrap metal.

Background

On 10 May 2013 the Minister of Economic Development (the Minister) issued a Trade Policy Directive to the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (ITAC) in terms of Section 5 of the International Trade Administration Act 71 of 2002.

The directive set out the policy in terms of which ITAC was to exercise its powers under the ITA Act in administering the exportation of ferrous and non-ferrous waste and scrap metal.

Renewal

The Minister is considering renewing the Policy Directive for a period of 9 months, during which period he intends to finalize a review of the directive.

Stakeholders and interested parties are requested to submit comments by **28 August 2018**.
